- Author's profile photographs (TIFF, EPS, High Resolution JPEG, BMP or PDF) (300 dpi at actual size)
- Charts, graphs, images and logos (TIFF, EPS, High Resolution JPEG, BMP or PDF) (300 dpi at actualsize)
- Article Length ~1500 words (plus references)
- Article is referenced in Vancouver Style
- Author's email and mailing address (we'll send copies to each author)
